- What worldly standards of spiritual success do you need to let go of?
- What could you do this week to remain connected to Jesus?



Warren W. Wiersbe puts it this way:

- The answer to "legalism" is the spiritual reality we have in Christ.
- The answer to "mysticism" is the spiritual union with Christ, the Head of the church.
- The answer to "asceticism" is our position in Christ in death, burial, and resurrection.



Things which encourage your development as a Disciple

Prayer - Specifically praying for the ministry that you are in or asking the Lord to give you a ministry where you are discipling another.

Scripture - Memorizing Scripture so that you can both reflect upon it and have it available as a tool in any situation-this series has eight key verses that relate to aspects of discipleship.

Personal testimony - Having a prepared, organized personal testimony that can be given in any situation.
