### Week One - THE MISSING KEY

Matthew 28:18-20

Jesus came and told his disciples, "I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth. Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

THEREFORE — Go, Baptize, and Teach is the KEY to unlocking our power and authority to live as a disciple of Jesus Christ.

Week Two - THE PRIMARY CONCERN

Matthew 6:33

Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need.

THEREFORE — God must be FIRST in our thoughts and actions.



#### Week Three - THE BOLD CONFESSION

Romans 9

If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

Luke 9:23

If anyone wishes to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily and follow me.

THEREFORE — Choose Jesus's way above all else when your thinking is in conflict with his.

### Week Four - 3 KEY WORDS

### ABIDE - John 15: 7-8

If you remain (<u>abide</u>) in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples.

### FRUIT - John 15:16-17

You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you so that you might go and bear <u>fruit</u>—fruit that will last—and so that whatever you ask in my name the Father will give you. This is my command: Love each other.

### **EXAMPLE - Ephesians 5:1**

Follow God's <u>example</u>, therefore, as dearly loved children and walk in the way of love, just as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us as a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God.
