Be Strong and Courageous WHY?

Jesus came and told his disciples, "I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth. Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Matthew 28:18-20

THEREFORE — Go, Baptize, and Teach is the KEY to unlocking our power and authority to live as a disciple of Jesus Christ.

Matthew 6:33

Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need.

THEREFORE — God must be FIRST in our thoughts and actions.



What is a Disciple

- What does it mean to bear the cross? "It means dying to self"
- A disciple must <u>love Jesus more than anyone or anything else</u>.
- A disciple must take up the cross and follow Jesus.
- A disciple must <u>turn the title deed of their life over to Christ</u>.
- A disciple must <u>impact their culture</u>.
- A disciple will <u>bring forth spiritual fruit</u>.

"And whoever does not bear his cross and come after Me cannot be My disciple." — Luke 14:27 NKJV



Hearts on Fire

Scottie Scheffler

When Scottie Scheffler after his Masters triumph, after becoming only the second golfer in history to win two Masters championships in his first five years on the tour, shot 29 on the back nine at the 2024 Olympics, we wanted to talk about it. We still talk about Jack's Nicklaus's back nine at Augusta in 1986.

C. S. Lewis captured it perfectly when he wrote, "I think we delight to praise what we enjoy because the praise not merely expresses but completes the enjoyment." As usual, Lewis gets it right! We have an inner compulsion to verbalize our feelings of worth toward someone of value or for an extraordinary accomplishment by another.

It seems that when the opportunity comes for us to share how wonderful God is, we are not as enthusiastic. *Many reasons keep Christians from telling others about Jesus: fear of rejection, feelings of inadequacy, lack of time building trusted friendships, etc.*



How Are We Doing?

- What defines me: "I believe in Jesus. Ultimately I think that's what defines me most".
- Why I play golf: "The reason why I play golf is I'm trying to glorify God and all that He's done in my life".
- My focus: "I've been called to come out here, do my best, compete and glorify God".
- My victory is secure: "My buddies told me this morning, my victory was secure on the cross".
- Jesus, not golf: "Jesus, not golf, defines me".
- Golf will pass away: "Golf will pass away, but Jesus will forever be there".
 - Scheffler has also dedicated his wins to God.



Are we Afraid of Persecution?

Sadly, many reasons keep Christians from telling others about Jesus: fear of rejection, feelings of inadequacy, lack of time building trusted friendships, etc.

If we spend time worshipping him in the beauty of holiness, we will soon find ourselves expressing our love for him to others.

- 1. Confident witnesses are filled with the Holy Spirit.
- 2. Spirit-filled witnesses obey God rather than men, even under the threat of persecution or death.
- 3. Confident witnesses have spent much time with Jesus and learned from Him.
