THE POWER OF KNOWING GOD A Path to Intimacy

What does intimacy with God mean?

It means bonding with Him in a close relationship

It means being vulnerable and trusting in one another

It means experiencing an abundant life that cannot be found anywhere else



THE POWER OF KNOWING GOD A Path to Intimacy

So how do we find the path to intimacy? Here are a few **approaches** we all use:

Prayer: Regular communication with God where we can express our gratitude, thoughts and feelings.

Study of Scripture : Reading and studying sacred texts can provide insights into God's nature, teachings, and expectations.

Inner Reflection: Spending time in solitude and introspection which helps us recognize our Christian beliefs and values.

Human Connection: Interacting with others, especially through acts of love, compassion, and service which reveals the God's plan for our lives.

Nature: Observing the beauty and complexity of the natural world which inspires awe and wonder, which leads to a deeper appreciation for the beauty of His creation.

Ultimately, the power of knowing God is unique to each of us as we seek our own path to intimacy. The important thing is learning how to develop a deep, personal connection with Him.

PREMISE OF TODAY'S DISCUSSION

If you develop a personal intimate relationship with God he will become both a friend and your King.

John 15:14-15 NIV says "You are my friends if you do what I command. ¹⁵ I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know his master's business. Instead, I have called you friends, for everything that I learned from my Father I have made known to you.

Most people have never met a King but my guess is that they would jump at the chance if they could.

Well, we have that opportunity when we read about our King in the Bible.

• The phrase *king of kings* is used in Scripture <u>six times</u>:

Once, the title is applied to God the Father (**1 Timothy** <u>6:14-15</u>), and twice to the Lord Jesus (Revelation 17:14-15 and 19:16)

• And in **Psalm 24:28**, Jesus is described as a powerful and mighty ruler.

- **1 Timothy 6:14:15 NIV says"...** I charge you to keep this command without spot or blame until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ, which God will bring about in his own time—God, the blessed and only Ruler, the King of kings and Lord of lords."
- **Revelation 17:14 NIV says** "They will wage war against the Lamb, but the Lamb will triumph over them because he is Lord of lords and King of kings and with him will be his called, chosen and faithful followers."
- **Revelation 16:16 NIV says**" On his robe and on his thigh he has this name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS."
- **Psalm 24"28 says** "Who is this King of glory? The Lord, strong and mighty, the Lord, mighty in battle."
