#### Joshua — Lessons

And I am come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians, and to bring them up out of that land unto a good land and a large, unto a land flowing with milk and honey; unto the place of the Canaanites, and the Hittites, and the Amorites, and the Perizzites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites.

[Exo 3:8 KJV]

#### Joshua — Lessons

A Christian doesn't work for victory,

#### He works from victory! (His)

Moreover, whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified.

[Rom 8:30 KJV]

A foreshadowing (model) of Christ

Namesake: Ye-ho-shua = Jesus in Greek

Prophet: foretold God's plan

Priest: Moses' minister (Ex 33:11)

King: Commander of the Host (Israel)

A foreshadowing (model) of Christ

- He came after Moses
- He leads to victory
- He's the advocate in defeat
- He allots the inheritance

#### Jordan River:

- Chose 2 spies: not 12
- Circumcised at Gilgal on 10<sup>th</sup> Nisan
- Crossed 3 days later on Passover
- Crossed at Bethabara: same place as John the Baptist preached

#### Jericho:

- •Bet Yerah: "House of the Moon God" (Islam?)
- Rahab: Gentile in Christ's genealogy

#### <u> Joshua – Personal background</u>

- Eldest son of his father, Nun
  - Some of his ancestors were cattle thieves
- Fought enemies soon after exodus
  - Moses instructed to write his name in "the book"
- Left in charge of tent of meeting (not Aaron)
- Along with Caleb, only ones to give good report
  - Stood his ground at threat of their life
